

# COMPONENTS OF A BRA

## APEX

Point at which the strap meets the bra, this too will relate to the cup size & style

## HOOK & EYE

The point at which the bra is secured around Enhances the anchorage of the bra. Increases with larger cups

## STRAPS

Help to balance the weight of the bust in the bra and width will relate to the cup size

## WING

This should offer firm control, and spread the pressure over an area rather than one point

## WIRES

This aids support & anchorage of a bra, the larger the bust the stronger the wires

## TRENLSLO

This helps strengthen the wing fabric and prevents it from collapsing Essential for larger cup support

## CUP

The fabric of the bra that encloses the breast and supports it.

## CENTRE FRONT

This is the central point of the bra between the cups, which sits flat on the breast bone, if the garment is fitting correctly

## CRADLE

Required to achieve anchorage of the bra and control the wires
